EXIT is an art project and design brand founded by spatial designer and artist Ceren Arslan. Specializing in concept architecture, spatial design, and storytelling, EXIT crafts extraordinary spaces that transport individuals to realms beyond the mundane. Through an architectural language rooted in out-of-the-box thinking, EXIT's projects provoke unconventional interpretations of familiar contexts, incorporating satirical and unexpected elements. Embracing the idea of escapism, EXIT's distinctive style and neo-brutalist aesthetic inspire both digital and physical productions. Collaborations with designers and brands further drive the boundaries of design, resulting in captivating products and imagery.

Ceren Arslan is a spatial designer and an artist based in New York City. She has been working and collaborating with brands as a concept designer expanding beyond her background from architecture. SHoP Architects, KPF and Kelly Wearstler are a few names she had her professional architecture practices at and recently Ceren joined Bureau Betak in their New York City office.

In addition to her professional practice, Ceren is a recognized artist via her art project and design brand: EXIT which specializes in concept architecture, spatial design, and storytelling. EXIT has been showcased at prestigious events such as Milan Design Week, NYC X Design, Miami Music Week, NFT NYC and Coachella, and she has received recognition from leading publications like Archdaily (with a Jury Award), Architect's Newspaper, Elle Decor, and Design Wanted. She is currently expanding her art project EXIT through different media of expression, collaborating with product designers like Pietro Franceschini, record labels and musicians like DJ Tennis and Carlita, fashion and spirits brands from LVMH as an art director. She has been installing EXIT Rooms as an expanded concept and a physical reality of the brand itself including product design.

Ceren received her Bachelor of Architecture from Pratt Institute NYC in 2018 graduating with the Top Honorable Mention Degree Project Award and still lives in New York City.

EXITROOM 0002 - DALMATIAN BLUE

Took its name from, one of the iconic darker shades of Porsche, 0002 Dalmatian Blue is a handsome setting of a home in a dalmatian pattern. Curated with select designed objects, the room mimics a typical apartment setting in a monochromatic format. Flattened out at first sight, the room receives its dimension as the visitors step into the blue setting.

Dalmatian Blue is an art installation displayed at NYC X Design 2023 at the Tuleste Factory.






The room is a real-life EXIT experience realized after its digital imagination. Featuring two chairs and a chess box designed by EXIT, the room invited other artists of the Tuleste Factory. It was the debut of painter Camila Varon for the gallery.











EXIT ROOM 0001 - GOLD RUSH

The very first EXIT Room experience took place at Senza Fine during NYFW February 2023. It was a super secret room dedicated to stimulating a completely different journey than the main stage. With open decks, the artists were invited to perform throughout the night. As part of Senza Fine World x Volcan Tequila partnership, the EXIT Room was dedicated to an exclusive VIP experience for the brand's new premium product Volcan X.A Tequila.

Inspired by the volcanic formations, the room was covered in monochromatic gold drapery. Uplit with soft sunset lighting as an ode to the design of the bottle, the room was a golden exit from the main room.


This room can only be unlocked by invitation and found through following the EXIT signs.








EXIT Room is a secret and more intimate room hidden at every Senza Fine party. It is designed around a different concept each time to elevate the experience of VIP guests.











EXIT - TENNIS TROPICAL

As part of Miami Music Week 2023, Senza Fine launched Senza Fine Kitchen in collaboration with W Hotels. On that special night DJ Tennis and Chef Bogin prepared a private dinner for 50 guests from the music industry which was hosted by Carlita and LP Giobbi.

The night was designed as a real life EXIT experience of an infinity dinner scene with a mirror installation which extended the 60' table to an endless perception. Ceren, as EXIT and the creative director of Senza Fine, created an immersive atmosphere that engaged both brands together with elevating the senses of sight, sound and taste altogether.

Guests included Diplo, Pete Tong, Damian Lazarus, Anfisa Letyago, Bedouin and more.








The dinner table was curated with small details hinting clues for the chef of the night DJ Tennis and the hosting brand Senza Fine. 10x12m mirror box illuminated with the brand's logo topped the 70 feet long table by creating an infinity effect. The florals were brought by Calma Floral.











RAISA VANESSA X SENZA FINE NYFW RUNWAY SHOW


Creative direction for NYFW Runway Show by Raisa Vanessa took place in September 2022. The brand displayed their Spring/Summer 2023 Collection. 80 foot long runway was framed by floor design inspired from the collection's new maximalist and joyful patterns backed by an 8 meter LED wall screening the collection's campaign. The show was followed by an afterparty in collaboration with Senza Fine, the second edition of Turkish-Italian DJ Carlita's multisensory high-fashion party concept.





The night lasted around 12 hours starting with the runway show and followed by a multi-room after party. It took over one of the largest event venues of Brooklyn activating both indoor and outdoor spaces.









TF: Lyorra Pissaro with the Allaux Brothers in collaboration with Quincy Ellis of Facture are showing two new works. The pieces, which are composed of projected images and resin frames, combine new technology with traditional techniques to explore the fluctuating nature of internal and external landscapes. We also have a special curation and immersive space called *EXIT Room #002: Dalmatian Blue* by spatial designer and artist Ceren Arslan who known for her work with Kelly Wearstler and EXIT. The name references a darker shade of porsche blue. This Dalmatian blue creates a handsome setting for a Dalmatian pattern. Curated with select designed objects, the room mimics a typical apartment setting in an immersive, monochromatic format. Flat upon first sight, the room receives its dimension as the visitors enter and become part of the work. As a gallery, we are dedicated to exploring and showcasing new concepts in contemporary design and art and the digital sphere is an important part of that.
